Sir Howard Davies served as the Director of the London School of Economics and Political Science (2003 - 2011). He is a regular participant in the World Economic Forum in Davos. From 1997-2003 he was Chairman of the FSA which was created under his leadership from nine separate regulatory agencies. From 1995-1997 he was Deputy Governor of the Bank of England, and former Director-General of the CBI, Controller of the Audit Commission, a director of GKN plc and a member of the International Advisory Board of Natwest. In 2004 he joined the board of Morgan Stanley as a non-executive director.

He is a Trustee of the Tate, a member of the governing body of the Royal Academy of Music; has Honorary Fellowship at Merton College. Since 2003 he has been a member of the International Advisory councils of the China Banking Regulatory Commission and the China Securities Regulatory Commission.
