Jean-Luc Dehaene is seen as the architect of state reform. He led Belgium into the Euro economy and reorganised the government finances. In 2008 he became chairman of Dexia Bank, a Belgian-French bank. He was appointed Vice-Chairman of the Convention on the Future of Europe in 2000. He has been a member of the European parliament since 2004 and is Minister of State - Mayor.

In detail

Jean-Luc Dehaene was the leading candidate to replace Jacques Delors as President of the European Commission. From 1971, he successively held the position of employee and advisor to a number of Ministerial Cabinets, and then worked as a Head of Cabinet for several different Ministers (amongst others, for the Prime Minister, Wilfried Martens). He first held a ministerial post in 1981. From 1981 to 1988, he was Minister for Social Affairs and Institutional Reform. From 1988 to 1992, he served as Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Traffic and Transport and Institutional Reform. Finally, as Prime Minister, he led two governments from 1992 to 1995 and subsequently from 1995 to 1999. He has been a member of the board of InBev and also Interbrew SA since 2001.
