Li has received continual recognition for her work in providing inspirational stimulus and fostering creative talent including the Netherlands' Grand Seigneur prize for her work in fashion and textile in 2004. In 2005, Aid to Artisans honoured her with a lifetime achievement award for her support of craft and design and in 2007 she was named Chevalier des Arts et des Lettres by the French Ministry of Culture and Communication. Every six months, Li Edelkoort, personally conceives the general Trend Book, which sets forth the main trends 2 years in advance. Printed in a limited edition of 250, this book expresses the trends in images, words, fabrics and materials that are sourced from all over the world and carefully assembled by the Trend Union team.
