Paul A. Volcker is an internationally renowned economist who was widely credited with ending the stagflation crisis in the US during the 1970s and early 1980s. He was Chairman of the Economic Recovery Advisory Board under President Barack Obama from 2009 to 2011.

In detail

Paul Volcker has received honorary degrees from several educational institutions. He was the Chairman of the Federal Reserve under US Presidents Jimmy Carter and Ronald Reagan (1979 to 1987). Between 2000-2004, he was a director of the United Nations Association of the United States of America, prior to his being appointed to the Independent Inquiry by Kofi Annan. As president, he also served as vice chairman of the FOMC. Previously, he served in a variety of positions with the Treasury, Chase Manhattan Bank, and the New York Fed. He was appointed as a member of the Hong Kong Chief Executive's Council of International Advisers 1998-2005. As of 2006, he is Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Washington-based financial advisory body, the Group of Thirty and a founding member of the Trilateral Commission.
