Mark Regan MBE started his Test career against the Springboks 13 years ago, was a World Cup winner in 2003 and a finalist in 2007. He played an integral part in the most recent campaign, playing in five matches including the final and won 47 international test caps. Having played an essential part in England's early 2008 RBS 6 Nations campaign, most notably in Paris, he then led the Barbarians to a 22-5 victory over South Africa at Twickenham. He had retired from international rugby in 2004 but made himself available, and was rewarded with a call-up for the tour of South Africa, where he started both tests and secured himself a World Cup place.
