Nicholas Parsons is the chairman of BBC Radio 4's Just a Minute, which has been on the air for 35 years. He received the Variety Club Award in 1967 as Radio Personality of the Year for the satirical programme Listen to this Space. In 1982 Nicholas starred in the radio play especially written for him entitled A High Pitched Squeak. Moreover, Nicholas has starred in numerous films, including Don't Raise the Bridge Lower the River with Jerry Lewis and Spy Story.

Nicholas Parsons remains an extremely high profile entertainer, holding his own live chat show in the Edinburgh Fringe Festival promoting up-and-coming comedians. He was the weekly guest presenter in 2005 on the BBC news quiz Have I Got News for You and he famously came last on BBC1's Celebrity Mastermind in 2007.
