His next show Omid Djalili was so successful he signed a major video deal with VVL. In 2000 he had another hit show Warm to my Winning Smile and in 2002 with Behind Enemy Lines both of these shows became Edinburgh's hottest ticket, receiving an astonishing six 5 star show for the latter (written post September 11th). On TV he did two seasons of Small Potatoes on Channel 4. In the States he signed a talent holding deal with NBC in 2002 and co-starred with Whoopi Goldberg in her sitcom Whoopi which ran from 2003-04.
