Born in Paris and of Vietnamese descent, Alizé turned professional in 2007. Her breakthrough moments include competing in four consecutive main draws at the French Open and being the only Frenchwoman to qualify for Roland-Garros in 2013. She spent her formative years training at elite academies before injuries led her to announce a transition toward media, eventually blending play with broadcasting. Since 2020, Alizé has excelled as a presenter and commentator for leading sports networks including Tennis Channel's Academy Life, Warner Bros. Discovery Sports, Eurosport, and France Télévisions. She has covered the Australian Open, French Open, and Paris 2024 Olympics, interviewing top athletes with credibility born from her athlete background.
