IN DETAIL:

Mark made his F1 debut with the Minardi Team in 2002. After moving to Red Bull Racing in 2007, he had his first F1 win in the 2009 German Grand Prix. Throughout his 12 years in F1, Mark notched up 215 races, nine victories, and accumulated an impressive tally of 42 podium finishes, 13 pole positions and 19 fastest laps. He also helped Red Bull Racing to four consecutive Constructors' World Championships. At the end of 2013 Mark rejoined sports-car racing as part of Porsche's return to the LMP1 class of the FIA World Endurance Championship in 2014. He and his teammates, amassed 14 podiums (eight of them victories) helped Porsche to the World Manufacturers Title twice, and became World Drivers' Champions in 2015. He retired from racing at the end of the 2016 WEC season.
