Matteo Renzi is the former Prime Minister of Italy and one of Europe's most dynamic and reform-minded political leaders. Renzi is the youngest person to serve as Italian Prime Minister and was the youngest leader in the G7. Following his time as Prime Minister, Renzi founded Italia Viva, a centrist political movement promoting pragmatic progress and civic renewal. He continues to serve as a Senator of the Italian Republic and remains a key figure in shaping Italy's reform agenda. In 2024, Renzi joined the Tony Blair Institute for Global Change as a Strategic Counsellor, where he contributes his experience to support international reform programmes and leadership development worldwide. He also serves on several international advisory boards and remains active in global dialogue on democracy, technology, and the future of governance.
